On 3 April 2003 the Queensland Parliament enacted the <i>Civil Liability Act 2003</i> , which, amongst other things, implements the recommendations of <i>The Review of Negligence – Final Report</i> (September 2002) (Ipp Report) in relation to causation and remoteness of damage. Flowing from these recommendations, this article examines the operation of the <i>Civil Liability Act's</i> provisions and contrasts the position under the Act with that existing at common law prior to its enactment.
