Animals

- Dogs – Offences – Bringing or permitting animal into a public place – “Public place” – Private land – Casino car park – Fenced with gaps – Not used for any other purpose at relevant time – *Local Government Act 1993*, s 3, Sch 2.

Contracts

- Building contracts – Adjudication – Application for stay of payment – Contention that respondent was not licensed under *Queensland Building Services Authority Act 1999* when entered into contract – Section 42(3) applies not to time of contractual relations but time when building work actually performed – Court reluctant to grant stay where no case of hardship and final position between parties can be worked out in larger proceedings – *Queensland Building Services Authority Act 1999*, s 42(3)
On Hing Pty Ltd v Phoenix Project Development Pty Ltd 216
- Building contracts – Challenge to adjudication – Contention that judgment was a nullity – Contract was with director not company – District Court’s inherent jurisdiction – Inherent jurisdiction not attracted – Various considerations – Intention of the legislature that such matters to be resolved simply and expeditiously – *Building and Construction Industry Payments Act 2004*, Pt 3, s 31.

Criminal law

- Appeal – Abuse of process – Strict liability – For environmental offence – *Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975* (Cth), s 38MC(2).

- Double jeopardy – Conviction under State law – Subsequent conviction under Commonwealth Act – Whether act or omission constituted same offence – *Transport Operations (Marine Safety) Act 1994*, s 43(1) – *Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Act 1975* (Cth), s 38MC(2) – *Crimes Act 1914* (Cth), s 4C(2).

- Offences – Public place, street or thoroughfare – “Public place” – Private property to which public is given free access – Casino car park – Fenced with gaps – Not used for any other purpose at relevant time – *Local Government Act 1993*, s 3, Sch 2.
Foxwell v Ive 49
- Prosecution – Leave to re-open – No error in giving leave to re-open – Prosecution took position that defendant had onus on particular matter – Ruling to contrary – Legitimate exercise of discretion to allow reopening of case in order to enable deficiency of proof to be supplemented.
Marshall v Averay 313
- Prosecution – Withdrawal of charges – Open for charges to be brought again – No res judicata – Charges can always be brought again subject to the discretion to stay – Applicant having no legitimate expectation that matter would not proceed further simply because charges were on one occasion withdrawn.

- Sentence – Discretion to not record conviction – Exercise of discretion – *Crimes Act 1914* (Cth), s 19B.

Environment and planning

- Planning offences – Unlawful use of premises – Operating entertainment venue on premises without permit – Interpretation of provision relating to use of premises – Provision creating single offence – Matters to be proved – Words used in complaint – Defendant having onus of showing that use was continuing pre-existing use and therefore lawful – *Justices Act 1886*, s 47(1) – *Integrated Planning Act 1997*, s 4.3.5.

Evidence

- Admissions – Exclusion – Failure by police to tape record or take notes of conversation at time alleged admissions made – No circumstance excusing failure – Not appropriate to exercise discretion – Evidence of admissions made by defendant to police officer must be excluded – *Police Powers and Responsibilities Act 2000*, ss 264, 266.
R v Higgins 155
- Hearsay – Exception – Person making representation incapable of giving evidence – Crown to show in positive way that it is unlikely that representation was fabricated – Balance of probabilities – Circumstances in which it was unlikely that representations were fabrication – No discretionary grounds for exclusion – *Evidence Act 1997*, s 93B.

- Judicial notice – Notice of statutory instruments – Act equates statutory instruments with statutes – Judicial notice to be taken by all courts of terms and commencement of any statutory instrument – Unnecessary for prosecution to prove date of commencement of local law and its content – *Evidence Act 1977*, s 43.

Local government

- Local laws – Prohibition on local laws that establish process about development that would be similar to process under *Integrated Planning Act 1997* – Local law regulating use of land was not one establishing a process about “development” – Local law valid – *Integrated Planning Act 1997*, s 1.3.2 – *Local Government Act 1993*, s 854(2).
