## CONTRACT

Informal agreements — Implied term — Copyright — Real estate agencies commissioned professional photography and floor plans of properties for use in marketing campaigns for sale or lease of properties — Real estate agencies given licence to use photographs and floor plans for purpose of marketing, and right to grant sub-licence for that purpose — Whether agencies' licence and right to grant sub-licence limited to period of marketing campaign for sale or lease of property.
