### **TRUSTS AND ESTATES**

Statutory interpretation — Section 49G Administration and Probate Act 1929 (ACT) — intestacy — Where beneficiaries are spouse and intestate's two children from previous marriage — Entitlement of spouse to appropriate dwelling house — Where value of dwelling house exceeds spouse's interest in intestate estate — Whether appropriation excludes interest of children.
