Information professionals have a lot to bring to the use of search, and can learn a great deal from other disciplines, such as software design, natural language processing, user experience and analytics. This article discusses two case studies of enterprise search implementations. The first case study details the implementation of Google Search Appliance at a Western Australian utilities company. The second case study examines the implementation of Lucene Solr at a Swedish health organisation. The third part of the article provides a summary of the key lessons from the case studies in terms of planning, resourcing and analytics. Calibre for ebook management – Jon Jermey				
Calibre is a free multi-platform, open-source application designed for the management of ebook collections. It includes searching capabilities, a generic ebook reader, an EPUB editor and internet links to find and retrieve metadata. Calibre will recognise external reading devices and allow their books to be transferred to and from a PC. It can be used as a server to provide access to an ebook collection on a local network or over the internet. Calibre will store and backup ebooks in DRM-protected formats, but is unable to display them in its reader.	75
