### PERSONAL PROPERTY

### PROCEDURE

- Costs — Departing from the general rule — Conduct of parties — Misconduct — Giving of evidence that is rejected not of itself relevant misconduct — Misconduct must have caused or contributed to the existence, continuation or extent of the litigation — Appropriate orders where litigation instituted and proceeded to trial because of both misconduct and unrelated cause.
